## Instructions

1. Register for free access to the FT at <https://join.ft.com/31f767cc-dcbe-4a7c-a4ee-98dd7811b305>

You must use a TAMUCC email address to register, as this is how the FT recognizes that you are eligible for a free month's trial subscription.



2. Over the next couple of weeks read some articles relating to macroeconomics. [Hint: Martin Wolf's articles are a good source, as are Larry Summers']

3. Pick an article that has a subject matter that you are interested in, but one that clearly deals with a macroeconomic issue of some kind.
4. Print out a copy as a pdf file of the article using the FT website ( - below the title of the article you should see the menu bar.



Keep this article in a folder, as you will also have to look at this again later in the course.

5. Now, do a short summary of what you understand the article to be saying. Use MS Word or equivalent word-processing software.
6. In the second paragraph, list any macroeconomic concepts that you can identify in the document (there might not be any), which you understand.
7. Next, in the third paragraph, list all the economic concepts or ideas that you do not understand in the article.
8. Then either i) provide a link to the URL where the article can be found or ii) do a clip of the article (in Windows 10), and paste this into the document.
9. Lastly submit your assignment to [www.turnitin.com](http://www.turnitin.com) for grading before the deadline (9/20). To do this you need to register with turnitin and then enroll in the class, which requires you to know the following:
